Format: 36 holes, stroke play competition (18 holes per day).

- Monday, July 13 Championship Course
- Tuesday, July 14 Main Course,

*The low 32 players will advance to match play competition on Wednesday, July 15th on the Main Course

Rules of Play: The 2008-2009 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MGA rules card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Dress Code: Proper dress code for all stages (including practice rounds) of the competition will be strictly observed. Mock tees and cargo style shorts are not permitted.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: Automotive Transportation and pull carts are not permitted. Caddies at The Country Club will be available and competitors are encouraged to use a club caddie (Please refer to the caddie requirements from practice round information below). If you wish to reserve a caddie, please call the Caddie Master (x630) at your earliest convenience.

Distance Devices: Competitors may use devices that measure or gauge distance only.

Time of Starting: Play will begin at 7:30am off the 1st and 10th tees. *A shuttle cart will be available for transportation to the 10th Tee on Monday.* Please be sure to be at your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior to your starting time to insure that all proper instructions are received from the starter. **The clock at the 1st and 10th tees is the official time.**

Courtesy Practice Rounds: Starting times will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Please call Kim Hall in the TCC Pro Shop (x604) for starting time availability. Consistent with the rules for member play, competitors will be required to use a club caddie only for practice rounds at a rate of \$65.00 per bag. **Date and Time Availability is as follows:**

Food Service: Concessions will be available starting at 7am in The Stables, along with lunch from 11:30am-2:30pm. The Hut will be available daily from 8am-6pm.

Golf Shop & Practice Facilities: The Golf Shop and Practice Facilities, including locker rooms will be open at 6:00am. During those hours, range balls are complimentary.

Designated Cell Phone Area: Cell Phones are permitted in the following locations ONLY: The Stables, Skeet Hut & Main Pond House Hut

Parking: Competitors will be checked in at the entrance to the club. Spectator parking will be available on the street adjacent to the club. Police officers will be available to direct spectators to appropriate locations and a courtesy shuttle to the clubhouse will be available.
