Format: Competition will be 36 Holes of Stroke Play. Players will be re-paired based on the first round results. Times will be available at www.mgalinks.org shortly after the completion of Round 1. *Any tie for first place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off on August 11th.*

Rules of Play: The 2008-2009 USGA Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MGA rules card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Dress Code: Please refer to the MGA rules card.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use and are available at the player's expense for \$13 per player. Pull carts are permitted.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:00 am in groups of 3 at 9 minute intervals. Please be sure to be at the 1st tee at least 10 minutes prior to insure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Courtesy Practice Rounds: Practice rounds can be arranged by calling the Golf Shop at (413) 734-9334.

Golf Shop: The Golf shop, including the clubhouse will be open at 6:00 am.

Practice Facilities: An 80yd facility is available at Franconia GC along with a practice putting green. A full practice facility will be available at: **Twin Hills Country Club**; 700 Wolf Swamp Road Longmeadow, MA 01106.
