Courtesy Practice Rounds: Courtesy Practice Rounds are available. Please call the Golf Shop for starting time availability. Contestants are limited to **one** courtesy practice round. In view of damage caused by play of extra balls during practice rounds, the USGA asks players not to abuse the courtesy extended by the club in the use of its course. The USGA requests that each player play only one ball at each hole during the practice round. During practice rounds, practice on a putting green is permissible, provided play by a following group is not delayed.

GOLF SHOE POLICY: Maplegate CC has implemented a policy prohibiting the use of golf shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes. As such, it will be a condition of the competition for the U.S. Amateur Qualifying that such spikes will not be permitted for use. Penalty for breach of this condition is Disqualification.

Round 1 Tee Times: Will begin at 7am off the 1st & 10th Tees.

Round 2 Tee Times: Will begin approximately **20** minutes after the completion of Round 1 on the opposite tee played from Round 1.

Distance Devices: The use of distance measuring devices is *prohibited*. Penalty for breach of this rule: **Disqualification**.

Cellular Telephones: The use of cellular telephones is prohibited.

Automotive Transportation: Automotive transportation is **not** permitted.

Golf Balls: The One-Ball Rule will be in effect.

Practice Facilities: The practice facilities are available.

Golf Shop: The Golf Shop will be open at 6:00 a.m.

Dress Code: Please observe the USGA dress code as stated in the U.S. Amateur Championship application.

Round 2: Please be aware that an 18-hole cut may be implemented, based on Round 1 Scores.
