Courtesy Practice Rounds: A Courtesy Practice Round is available. (Call for times and identify yourself as a contestant). Each contestant is limited to **one** courtesy practice round. Courtesy practice round privileges will be honored only during the aforementioned time and date; requests for alternate times will not be considered. In view of damage caused by play of extra balls during practice rounds, the NEGA asks players not to abuse the courtesy extended by the club in the use of its course. The NEGA and the USGA requests that each player play only one ball at each hole during the practice round.

Withdrawals: Please advise the NEGA office immediately at (774) 430-9020 if you are unable to compete. Failure to advise the NEGA office may disqualify the player from future USGA competition. If there is a need to call the NEGA office after the close of business on Friday, May 8th, please call Harry McCracken (NEGA) at (774) 265-0775.

Caddies & Automotive Transportation: Players may bring a caddie, however no local caddies are available. *Parents may not caddie.* Automotive Transportation is **not** permitted for players.

Distance Devices: The use of distance measuring devices is prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **Disqualification.**

Cellular Telephones: The use of cellular telephones is prohibited.

Golf Balls: The One-Ball Rule will be in effect. See Appendix I of the Rules of Golf.

Practice Facilities: The Practice Range is available.

Golf Shop: Open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Dress Code: Please observe the USGA dress code as stated in the USGA Junior Amateur application.

Round 2: Please be aware that an 18-hole cut may be implemented, based on Round 1 Scores.
