Courtesy practice round privileges will be honored only during the aforementioned time and date; requests for alternate times will not be considered. In view of damage caused by play of extra balls during practice rounds, the NEGA asks players not to abuse the courtesy extended by the club in the use of its course. The NEGA and the USGA requests that each player play only one ball at each hole during the practice round.

Cellular Telephones: The use of cellular telephones is prohibited.

Golf Ball: The One-Ball Rule will be in effect. See Appendix 1 of the Rules of Golf.

Practice Range: The Practice Range is available at 7:00am.

Locker Room and Golf Shop: Open at 7:00 a.m.
