Format: The competition will be 36 Holes at Stroke Play. The field will be cut to the low 60 scorers & ties after Round 1. Players will be re-paired for Round 2, based on the Round 1 results. Starting Times will be available at www.mgalinks.org shortly after the completion of Round 1. *Any tie for first place will be decided immediately by a hole-by-hole play-off on August 9th.*

Schedule: Tuesday, August 8th - Round 1, 18 Holes – *The field will be cut to the low 60 scorers & ties for Round 2*
Wednesday, August 9th - Round 2, 18 Holes

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MGA Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use and are available at the player's expense for \$20 per player (only two golf carts per group will be permitted during the Championship Proper). The use of push/pull carts is also permitted.

Round 1 Starting Times: Play will begin at **8:00am (Morning Wave)** and **12:00pm (Afternoon Wave)**, in groups of 3, at 10-minute intervals, off the 1st & 10th tees. Please make sure to be at your starting tee **at least 10 minutes prior** to insure that all proper instructions are received from the starter.

Round 2 starting times will begin at 7:30am from the 1st tee only.

Players starting on the 10th tee, please be advised that additional info about transportation to the 10th tee will be provided at a later date.
