Format: 18 holes, stroke play qualifying. The top **17 qualifiers and ties** will move on to the championship proper at Wyantenuck Country Club in Great Barrington, MA on September 6-7, 2017. The number of qualifying spots is subject to change based on any withdrawals prior to the competition.

Rules of Play: The 2016 Rules of Golf are in effect and are supplemented by the MGA Hard Card. The Committee will provide any additional Local Rules needed at the championship site. It is the individual player's responsibility to know the Conditions of the Competition.

Golf Carts: Golf carts are permitted for use during the qualifying round and are available at the player's expense - \$20 per player.

1st Tee Time: Play will begin at 7:30am, in groups of three, at nine-minute intervals, off the 1st tee. Please be sure to be at **your starting tee at least 10 minutes prior** to your scheduled starting time.

Tees: Approximate yardage for the Qualifying Round will be 6,000 yards (White/Blue Tees).

Practice Round: A practice round can be scheduled by calling the golf shop in advance and introducing yourself as a competitor in the qualifying round: **(781) 862-9614**. There will be a **MANDATORY** cart fee of \$20 per player for their practice round.

Available Dates/Times: Wed., July 19th (all day), Thur., July 27th (all day), Fri., July 28th (before 10am)

Sat. & Sun., July 29th & 30th (after 6:00pm) – carts will **NOT** be available on the 29th & 30th

Club Facilities: The golf shop and clubhouse will be available at 6:30am. Food and Beverage will be available at the player's expense (cash or credit).

Practice Range Facilities: There is **NO** driving range on site. Hitting nets and a practice putting green/short game area will be available.

Score Posting: All scores from individual stroke play events (qualifiers & championships proper) will be automatically posted to a player's MGA/USGA Handicap Index by the MGA.
