Entries accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. All proceeds go directly to the MGA Junior Golf Fund which supports The First Tee of Massachusetts.

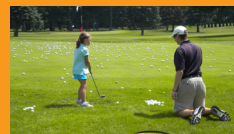
Current Programs:
