Current Programs:

Today, The First Tee of Massachusetts currently has program sites in Norton, Springfield, Lynnfield, Hyannis and Boston.

Each of these sites hosts children each year who take part in the golf and life skills curriculum of The First Tee.

Worcester Country Club:

Founded in 1900, Worcester has a long and storied past featuring names such as Hagen, Jones, Nelson, Sarazen and Rawls. It was designed by architect Donald J. Ross, who personally oversaw the design and construction of the course that stretches over 6650 yards and plays to a par of 70. Worcester C.C. hosted the 1925 Men's U.S. Open and the 1960 Women's U.S. Open. However Worcester is best known as the site of the inaugural Ryder Cup, in 1927. The First Tee of Massachusetts is proud to be partnering with Worcester Country Club for such a significant event. Don't miss your chance to play at one of Massachusetts's historic golf courses!
